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PROCEDURAL GUIDE

Nominating Non-local (Grandfather/Grandmother) Fellow

Non-local (Grandfather/Grandmother) Fellowship Program

The Academy of Nursing & Midwifery (HKANM) was incorporated the 6th day of October 2011 with 14 Academy Colleges. A new category of non-local fellowship for the HKANM is established in 2024 to enhance global collegiality,

Eligible Criteria

Grandfather/Grandmother Non-local Fellow is a registered nurse / registered midwife trained outside Hong Kong and is registered in his/her country/jurisdiction of practice with over 15 years in specialized practice and has successfully approved by the HKANM within 2 years of the establishment of the new category of non-local Fellow Membership (i.e. on or before 28 February 2026). Among these 15 years of specialty-related experience, 7 years must be in the named specialty (as reflected in the Fellow title in application), including the most recent and current 5 years; and has demonstrated significant contribution to specialty service development which must be reflected by substantiated impact or evidenced outcomes. Moreover, in the opinion of the Council, the conduct of his / her practice is consistently good throughout such years and at present.

Nomination Requirements

- 1. The applicant shall then be nominated by at least one an Institutional Member (the Academy College of HKANM).
- 2. The nominator College should ensure that the form is accurately completed and substantiating documents are attached before sending to the Registration and Membership Committee (R&MC). Applications must be vetted by TWO Fellows in good standing with the Academy College.
- 3. The application shall be checked by the R&MC to assess its eligibility basing on the criteria to become a non-local fellow.
- 4. The completed summary report of the nomination shall be submitted by the R&MC to the Council for endorsement of fellow membership.



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Guidance Notes on the Inclusion of Contribution

Examples of areas considered as **significant contributions** to nursing profession (the list is not exhaustive):

A. In leadership position of specialty-related activities

e.g. in-charge of service or project, or leaders of clinical teams.

- Project team leader (routine, job-related functions are not counted)
- Department manager (shift or unit in-charge, day-to-day functions are not counted)
- **B.** Invited member in local, national and/or international initiatives e.g. Council Member; invited member of conference/ seminar Organizing Committee or invited panel member of professional bodies.
 - Members of the Council or Executive Committee (not counting ordinary member) of professional bodies (not counting hospital/ departmental committees).
 - Local initiatives are pegged at cross departments/ hospitals/ corporate levels. Speakers/ organizers/ coordinator/ facilitator of in-service programs are not counted.
- C. Demonstrated contributions in nursing practice and service development e.g. being a specialty mentor, speaker, facilitator, moderator, coordinator or organizer in specialty care related training and development programs; or paper submission on innovative nursing practice.
 - *i. Mentors for specialty trainees (including midwifery)*
 - *ii.* Clinical instructor/assessors for undergraduate students (for > 1 university/tertiary education institution)
 - iii. Speakers/course coordinators / visiting lecturers for PRCC programs
 - *iv.* Presentation at conferences (including both oral and poster presentation)

Minimum Level of Contribution (accepted by R&MC)

- A. For recognition to be grandfather fellow of the specialty, the minimum significant contribution was that the applicant must possess at least 2 of the 4 areas (Section IV A/B/C/D). If only one area is involved, there should be at least 2 projects / programs / activities in that specific area.
- B. Some examples illustrating activities / project not considered as significant contributions:
 - WTO / Olympics or Paralympics stand-by / overseas stand-by duties;
 - Training activities for OSH / Infection Control; Nursing Audit; Fire Drill; Disaster Drills within own ward / department;
 - All job-related activities at ward / department;
 - Link Nurse/ Unit Representative to project / program;
 - Extra duties with Special Honorarium.
