








Singapore's Ageing Population









Medisave

Compulsory medical savings scheme introduced in 1984, 8 to 10.5% of monthly salary goes to Medisave


MediShield Life

Basic health insurance plan to help pay for large hospital bills and selected costly outpatient treatments (dialysis, chemotherapy, etc) Risk pooling.

Medifund

Safety net for the needy who cannot afford medical expenses, even after government subsidy, Medisave and MediShield Life

- 3. clinical competencies for expanded practice



Structured APN

Principle

Continual assessment:

- Providing objective, timely, regular & structured feedback
- 2. Measuring performance in context
- 3. Completing an objective structured final assessment

Formative Assessment

- 1. Mini-CEX x4
- 2. Chart stimulated recall x2
- 3. Case logs x100
- 4. Journal club presentations x2
 - i) Assess knowledge, skills & attitude
 - ii) Assure objectivity by multi-rater, multiencounter

Competency Assessment

Regulation

- 1. SNB registers APN under one of four tracks
- 2. Nurses & Midwives Regulation provides for APN Accreditation Committee to appoint a third party to set and conduct the examination

Summative Assessment

Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE)

- 1. Patient Care
- 2. Clinical Knowledge
- 3. Communication skills
- 4 Professionalism

APNs Role (NUH)

Direct Care Provider (Nurse Practitioner's Role)

- Perform health & physical assessment
- Order and interpret diagnostic test
- Furnish medications according to protocols
- Initiate treatments according to protocols
- Plan and manage patients in collaboration with collaborating physician

APNs (Hybrid Roles)

> Clinical Leader (Clinical Nurse Specialist's Role)

- Mentoring / Teaching
- Leadership in Professional Development
- Consultancy Resource
- Research and Evidencebased Practice






