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## **Message from The President**

In parallel with striving for excellence in advanced nursing practice, the Hong Kong Academy of Nursing (HKAN) has always been committed to serving the society especially during the pandemic. For the past three years, the HKAN had operated a total of seven Community Vaccination Centres/ Stations.

With the closing of Vaccination Stations at Caritas Medical Centre and Tang Shiu Kin Hospital on 28 April 2023, we remarkably completed our mission of helping in the fight against COVID-19 to safeguard health and safety of people in Hong Kong.



In total, the HKAN has contributed more than 92,000 hours in vaccination service through the dedicated commitment of 230 doctors, nurses and healthcare assistants working in these centres/ stations.

According to the International Council of Nurses, nurses have been recognised as an important force for global health, and nurses' contributions are one of the key factors of winning in this worldwide healthcare crisis caused by COVID-19. I am proud of being a nurse! As the President of HKAN, I would like to sincerely thank all our Fellows and Members, once more, for working days and nights at the beside to deliver high quality care to people in Hong Kong regardless of time or place, or whether there is a crisis!

With the removal of various restrictive pandemic measures and the resumption of normalcy, the HKAN has returned to its routines in all health and nursing related activities. We successfully conducted the HKAN Fellowship Conferment Ceremony on 3 December 2022, which was the first face-to-face event after the pandemic, for Fellows of 2020 and 2021. On 21 October 2023, we will conduct the Conferment Ceremony for Fellows of 2022 and 2023. This time, we will have a record-high number of inductees whose significant achievements in advanced nursing practice will be well recognised in the ceremony. The ceremony will take place at the Hong Kong Metropolitan University.

With the resumption of normal travel between Hong Kong and mainland China, our 14 College Presidents together with the Office Bearers and Consultants of HKAN attended an event organised by the Guangdong Nursing Association, which is a branch of the Chinese Nursing Association, on 12 May 2023. We joined the International Nurses' Day Ceremony cum Honorary Advisor Appointment Ceremony of the Greater Bay Area Specialty Nursing Alliance in Guangzhou. This signifies the importance of HKAN's involvement in the advanced nursing practice development in the Greater Bay Area and with more collaborations to be expected in the near future.

The Hong Kong Academy of Nursing 香港護理專科學院 LG1, School of Nursing, Princess Margaret Hospital, 232 Lai King Hill Road, Lai Chi Kok, Hong Kong Email: info@hkan.hk Tel: (852) 2370 0335 Fax: (852) 2370 0216 website: http://www.hkan.hk 二〇二三年一月二十七日 香港護理專科學院 - 2023/24年度 財政預算諮詢 香港護理專科學院表示全力支持政府2023/24年度的施政報告,本學院針對財政預算 的優先及重點,有以下具體提議。 I. 補充護理人手 因退休及移民潮,除人手極度不足外,無論公私營醫療服務單位都出現嚴重斷層。 建議政府撥款: (1) 除了加大護理本科 (UGC) 培訓及指定專業課程資助計劃 (SSSDP) 學額外,應 指定資助專科培訓,例如臨床護理碩士、專科護理課程等。 (2) 資助助理人員的培訓,以強化日常護理能力;並釐定護理員在社區照料病者 的職權範圍, 達致更大的成就國;亦須整合為護理團隊,促進助理人員的 歸屬咸。 II. 促進精神健康 社交隔離和經濟下滑今港人承受沉重的精神壓力,尤其弱勢社群更甚。 建議政府撥款: (1) 資助大專院校或其他機構增加開辦精神科護理註冊後專科培訓 (Postregistration Certificate Course, PRCC),尤其著重在社區以家庭為本的個案照顧。 (2) 在公共醫療增加精神科高級護師(Advanced Practice Nurse, APN)及顧問護 師(Nurse Consultation, NC)職位,以善用護理才能,承擔病情進展及治療 方案導循度的個案監察。 III. 拓展基層醫療 須充分運用地區康健中心 (District Health Centre, DHC),有效地落實以家庭為中心 的理念,按人生歷程規劃促進健康和預防疾病併發症的模式。 建議政府撥款: (1) 強化以家庭為本的社區健康意識,今家庭主婦有能力促進家人健康,及早發 現疾病徵兆;亦令照顧者有能力料理居家護養人士,減低安老和殘疾院舍的 需求。 (2) 饭常化社區護理專科培訓及發展 DHC 護士診所,進行慢性病評估及管理, 為疾病第二級和第三級預防作把關,以及控制病徵不適或疼痛,減少對醫院 的壓力。 IV. 加強註冊監管 面對醫療服務的轉營、醫療人手的配合和補充,應加快各項立法規管。 建議政府撥款,增加護士管理局人手,以便: (1) 確立專科護士法定註冊制度,應加快立法令護理專科學院成為法定機構,從 而協助訂定專科護士的自主執業範圍和規範。 (2) 加速非本地護士暫准/有限度註冊制度的立法,吸納更多外地人才和促進大 灣區共融。 如有查詢:可聯絡香港護理專科學院院長車錫英教授 2370-0335

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## **Response to Government Policy**

#### 2023年3月19日〈護士註冊條例〉(第164章)修訂建議的立場聲明

#### 香港護理專科學院對〈護士註冊條例〉(第164章)修訂建議的立場聲明

香港護理專科學院(護專)及其下14所專科學院充份了解本港醫護人手嚴重 短缺和流失率持續上升,令醫護服務水平下降,對市民帶來負面的影響,亦 對醫護同業產生沉重的壓力。我們支持政府設立渠道及機制讓非本港註冊護 士能來港填補本港的醫護人手不足。

我們冀望政府確保:

- 由法定護士監管機構審核非本地培訓畢業護士的資格,以確保本港市民 能適時獲得具質素的醫護服務。
- 2) 本港護士的護理專業發展以及受聘和晉升機會不受影響。

對於引入不同的護士註冊途徑方面,護專有以下意見:

- 清楚界定有限度註冊/登記、特別註冊/登記和暫時註冊/登記等各種制度的定義、暫准註冊的時限和受聘機構性質和名單。我們建議參考香 港醫生及專職醫療的專業註冊制度。
- 2) 特別註冊/登記和暫時註冊/登記制度並不適用於登記護士。
- 清楚及仔細列明准入的標準,包括學歷水平、受訓院校名單、護理年 資和所具經驗。
- 所有正規護士註冊及登記制度必須通過護士管理局所訂定的執業考 試,不能以僱主機構批核為準則。

對於護理發展方面,護專有以下意見:

- 我們支持將<u>持續教育</u>訂為領取執業證明書的先決條件。惟政府應同時 拓展及資助護理持續教育的基礎設施及運作。
- 成立法定的專科護理培訓和監管機構,以確保香港護理保持於國際水 平和領導地位。

香港護士管理局作為本港的一個法定監管機構,通過建立及執行註冊/登記制 度,保證香港護理服務的質素能切合本港不斷轉變的社會對醫護服務的需求; 規管和監察執業護士之專業操守及擁有紀律處分權。在確保市民得到一個有 質素和安全的護理服務的同時,也要確保本港的專科發展切合本港醫療服務 的發展,並且要融合國際護理發展水平。在設定特別註冊制度時,需要有嚴 謹制度,確立專科護理的培訓及所需的考試認証。護專和 14 所專科學院作為 被業界及大眾認同的高級專科護理的領導代表,我們願意積極參與在此方面 作出貢獻。

## **Report from Prof. Sylvia FUNG**

ICN represents more than 28 millions nurses worldwide. The Triennial Congress offered a platform for nurses to share and advance together.





Nursing Image has been a sub-theme "Caring with Courage", nurses "have gone above & beyond in providing care amidst challenging circumstances such as pandemic".
