Message from President

I wish to start by expressing my deepest gratitude to our nurses who are working in the frontline and day-to-day service operation these days. Like what Dr Trudeau has said, where there is no medication for the cure, we can always comfort and promote healing. 


The HKAN has established competence and standards of advanced nursing practice, introduced a system in place for accreditation of the specialty Colleges and certification of advanced practice nurses in different specialties. The Nursing Council of Hong Kong (NCHK) recently has submitted a proposal report to the Food & Health Bureau on the 'Implementation of the Voluntary Scheme on Advanced and Specialised Nursing Practice'. The HKAN has repeatedly communicated with NCHK and the Food & Health Bureau asserting that the HKAN is the only professional body in Hong Kong that has done the ground work, over the last 15 years, in setting standards and building mechanisms for advanced nursing practice with the involvement of nurse leaders and clinical experts in both the public and private sectors. We have been working with the 3 universities that offer Master degree, the private hospitals and the Hospital Authority to facilitate theoretical learning and clinical mentorship in attaining the HKAN Fellowship. We appeal to NCHK not to reinvent the wheels nor duplicate the efforts, but consider involving HKAN and Academy Colleges as a certifying agent. We need a unified effort of the Academy Colleges and each one of you so that we do not waste the efforts of our predecessors and optimize the contribution and achievements of HKAN in the process of achieving statutory status of advanced practice nurses.

We are very fortunate to have 4 new Council Members in the coming term. Dr Chow Yu-fat and Mr Andrew Tse are lay members in the profession of medicine and law respectively. Their support to the HKAN is invaluable. We have to thank our outgoing lay Members Professor Martin WONG and Ms Elaine LIU who have equally contributed greatly to the HKAN. Both of them were awarded the HKAN Honorary Fellowship. We welcome Professor CHAIR Sek Ying and Professor Sylvia FUNG who are elected Members of the new Council. Professor CHAIR is also elected as the President-Elect who will take over the Presidency after I complete my term in 2020.

In the last Fellowship Conferment in May 2019, we have admitted 34 new Fellows. Now we have a total of 84 Earned Fellows and they have formed a Young Fellow Chapter to work alongside with the main Council to drive nursing forward. These young Fellows have made an impressive video to introduce the work of advanced specialized nurses in selected areas. You can view the youtube at “[讓專科護理為你健康導航](#)”. We look forward to the admission of more new Fellows in the coming years.

The HKAN is about promoting quality care with the best nursing skill set we can offer to the public. Patch Adams once said, ‘You treat a disease, you win, you lose. You treat a person, I guarantee you, you’ll win, no matter what the outcome’. To cure sometimes, to relieve often, to comfort always. Professor CHAIR Sek Ying was elected as Council Member



The establishment of the Hong Kong Academy of Nursing (HKAN) marks an important milestone or, more specifically, a big leap forward in the development of nursing specialization in Hong Kong. I am honored to be elected as Vice President (External) of HKAN. I eagerly look forward to work collaboratively with the 14 Colleges, fellows and members of HKAN to promote the preparation and registration of specialty nurses and the development and regulation of advanced nursing practice in Hong Kong.

Undoubtedly, we need to have more fully prepared and qualified advanced practice nurses in various specialties to serve the increasingly complex health care environment. The current major challenges including rapid population ageing, increased prevalence of chronic diseases, and serious health care manpower shortage have resulted in overcrowded public hospitals, long patient waiting time, and overwhelming stress and burn-out among doctors and nurses. It is worrisome that all these have become common phenomena negatively affecting the quality of health care in Hong Kong.

With the current health care model existing for centuries, changes are needed to facilitate its evolution with time. Currently, the suboptimal quality of health care is not agreed by many nurses, who suggest a need of health care reform and would like nurses to involve more in advanced nursing practice in the reform. Surely, no one can decide the scope of practice for nursing except nurses and the public. Our society pressingly needs more advanced practice nurses with enhanced specialty knowledge and skills, capable of developing and delivering new models of care to ultimately benefit patients and the public with better health care.

Nursing has been commented as ‘The oldest career but the youngest profession’. With its vigorous growth in the past decades, specialization development in nursing has become an inevitable trend in both local and global contexts. Only with concerted effort, we can speed up this specialization process and advocate for change to meet new health care challenges ahead.

Change is the key to everything, and I believe together we can make change happen.

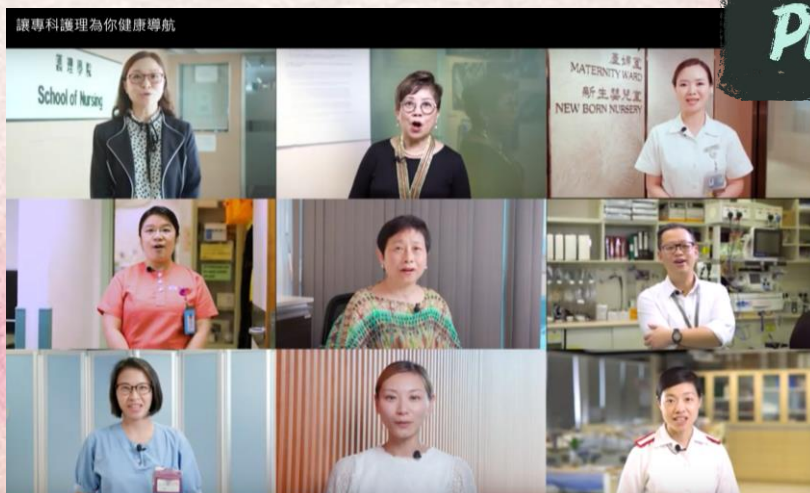

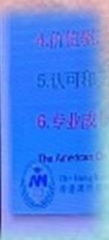

北京國際護理研討會暨醫院參訪活動後記

4/9/2019 – 8/9/2019

9月6日研討會正式開始。開幕式讓人印象深刻，當中巨細無遺地展示了中華護理學會 110年的歷史見證。1909年在信寶珠赫特夫人的倡議和帶領下，中國護士會便誕生了。建立護理標準、開發現代化護理教育，制定護士學校註冊管理辦法，創辦“護士季報”及編譯書籍、參加國際交流等等。1964年正式更名為中華護理學會。2013年重返國際護士會，融入國際護理大家庭。從『看護』到『護士』，從『護病』到『護理』專業及專科發展。自1954年已有中華護理雜誌，學術氛圍濃厚、搭建交流平台，人才培養、提升護理水平。2002年中國為首個專科護士培訓項目開始啟動。至今，對護理專業的認可卓越。至今日更有80多名中國護士得到國際紅十字會頒發的南丁格爾獎。展望未來，學會亦積極參與國家護理規劃及護理教育改革，以至護理條例的頒佈，護理人員在社會的地位、保障護理人員合法權益提升。專家團隊面對逆境，例如汶川大地震、非典型疫情、印尼海嘯、伊博拉疫情等等。全國共400萬多名護理同仁共同協作努力。當中強大的凝聚力，令人感動！

是次大會邀請了國際護士會(ICN)主席 Annette Kennedy，世界衛生組織(WHO)首席護士官Elizabeth Iro及來自歐、美及一帶一路地區護理學會主席出席演講。大會內容廣泛地包括了：1. 護理管理，2. 臨床護理實踐，3. 護理教育，4. 護理信息化，大數據之使用智慧病房及護士站之建設，5. 護理科研創新與及期刊發展，對於循證醫學及臨床護理創新思維的新進展。

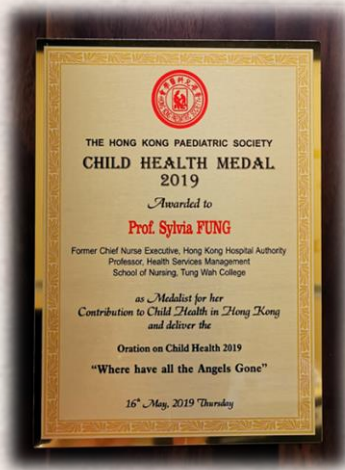

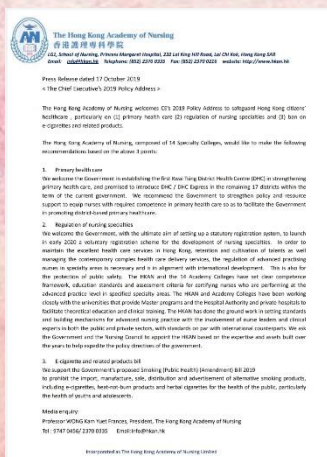
